"Not Guilty by Reason of Insanity (NGRI): Best Practices for Outpatient Coordination, Collaboration, and Reporting," highlights bast practices for local mental health authorities (LMHA), local behavioral health authorities (LBHA) and their partners for coordinating, communicating and completing reporting requirements related to people found not guilty by reason of insanity and court-ordered to outpatient treatment and supervision in the community.
